TOUR CONDITIONS AND INFORMATION

RESERVATIONS:

A deposit of \$1,000 per person is required to make a reservation for this tour. Your check should be made payable to SMAA with a notation (SMAA/HLP/2027). Confirmation of your reservation will be sent to you after the deposit is received. The check must be received by us by 4:00pm on the same day you register. Bring the check to the church office located at 8100 Lomo Alto Drive, Suite 125, Dallas, TX 75225. Enter through the east doors and Suite 125 will be on your immediate right. The receptionist will receive your check and bring it to Bhav.

SHARED AND SINGLE ACCOMMODATIONS:

Passengers must indicate at the time of booking whether they want to share a room or if they prefer a single supplement for an additional \$2,100. Your roommate, if known, should also be indicated. Final room arrangements will be made based on the demographic makeup of the pilgrims. Families will have the option to room with their children, and children will have the option to room together following safe church guidelines. If you do not have a roommate, we will attempt to find a suitable traveling companion to share a room with you. If you join the tour less than 90 days prior to departure and we cannot identify a roommate for you, you will be charged the full single supplement.

ADDITIONAL PAYMENTS:

A second payment of \$1,000 per person is due 180 days before departure (September 10, 2026). The final payment of \$2,700 per person is due no later than 90 days before departure (December 11, 2026). If you are joining the tour within 90 days of departure, full payment is required at the time of your reservation.

INSURANCE:

We recommend that passengers buy insurance to protect themselves against any possible tour cancellation charges or out of country medical expenses. Withdrawal from the trip at any time will result in forfeiture of payments made.

PASSPORTS AND VISAS:

A passport is required for all tour participants and should be valid for at least **six months** past your scheduled return date. If you do not already have a passport, please apply for one without delay. If your present passport expires prior to October 2027, you must renew it before the tour.

Visas are required for both Israel and Jordan. Israel issues individual visas at the airport upon entry. The Travel agency will obtain a group visa for Jordan.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:

At the time of printing, there are no health certificates or inoculations required to enter any of the countries listed on the tour.

ITINERARY VARIATIONS:

Raji Tours reserves the right to change the itinerary of the tour due to circumstances beyond our control. Every effort will be made to keep the tour as close as possible to the original itinerary. The political situation will be monitored closely to ensure that the group is protected against any disturbance in the areas visited.

RESPONSIBILITY:

Raji Tours acts as agents for the various owners/contractors providing hotels, means of transportation or other services, and the issuance and acceptance of such services shall be deemed to be consent to the further conditions that Raji Tours shall not become liable or responsible in any way for any personal or property loss, damage or injury howsoever caused or arising.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Airfare: Each pilgrim is responsible for arranging their own airfare. If requested, recommended airlines and routes will be provided.

Borders: Crossing the Israeli-Jordanian Land border is subject to government taxes and visa fees that are subject to change by the authorities (often on short notices) and are out of the Tour Operator control. If fees are increased, tour members will be responsible to pay the difference. Once across the border, the Jordanian tour company is fully responsible for the group and tours. Travelers who are refused entry at either border crossings by the authorities or who decide to withdraw at their own discretion at any stage during the tour will not be entitled to refunds.

Schedule: This tour has been designed to maximize our pilgrimage experience while missing the fewest number of school days. The itinerary is designed to allow the option of skipping Yad Vashem and leaving Jerusalem the morning of Sunday, March 21 to be back home that night and at work/school on Monday, March 22.

Smoking: Tour members are not permitted to smoke on motor coaches. There will be enough stops made so passengers who wish to smoke will not be inconvenienced.
